MEETING WITH THE MINISTER



On the 25th of July 2017 both Gurmeed Nelson-Aged Care Coordinator and I attended a special meeting organised by the Federal Member for Banks Mr David Coleman, to meet with the Hon Mr Ken Wyatt, Federal Minister for Ageing.

The purpose of the meeting was initially requested by us and our peers in the sector to meet with the Minister and express our concerns with the ongoing issues that we and our clients have been facing since the Aged Care reforms were introduced.

The meeting with the Minister proved to be very successful on the day. There were other representatives from Aged Care providers in the St George area present to also express their opinions and concerns.

What transpired as a result is that service providers were able to provide feedback to the Minister about the My Aged Care Gateway and talk of the experiences and frustrations with the Gateway referral pathway.

We also provided feedback on the integrated care at home submission which provided important information to the Minister and to the Department of Health on the aspects of the reforms that are working and those that are not.

In closing providers of Aged Care services in the St George Area, agreed as a united front in our advice to the Minister to consider some aspects of the Commonwealth Home Support Program (CHSP) funding to continue as block funding, as it is difficult to measure and package Day Care Services.

Minister Wyatt thanked all of those that attended and requested that we forward his office information on our services individually.

DISABILITY ART & DAY CARE ACTIVIY GROUP







The Kingsgrove Community Aid Centre Disability Art Class has been running since May 2017.

The feedback & suggestions we have received from the clients show just how much the participants have enjoyed coming together to do the fun activities provided for them. Since receiving this great feedback, KCAC has decided to continue this program and expand it to include more activities for the members in 2017.

The program has been renamed the Disability Art Class & Day-Care Activities Program to better reflect the bigger range of activities that have been added. As well as the existing art and craft such as painting/drawing, paper cuttings etc. we have included new activities for the group such as cooking classes, computer skills, video making skills, photography, singing, dancing and Rouli Ball exercise dances etc. These extra activities help them to learn skills to assist participants improve their independence. The program recommenced on 19th July 2017 and has attracted 6 new participants who have joined the original Art Class over the past 4 weeks. We now have 14 members in total who attend on a weekly basis.

This exciting new program occurs every Wednesday for 2 hours per day (10:30am-12:30pm) and will run for 20 weeks. The program will be re-evaluated in the 10th week of running to gather more feedback and ideas from the clients so that we can further expand on our activities in the future.

It is great to be able to provide this program which really makes a difference in the lives of many by helping to improve their social skills, confidence, ability to concentrate and to encourage them to use their creativity and imagination.




